Bring Your Own Device

From the beginning of 2018 students at Tauranga Boys' College are recommended and strongly encouraged to bring an appropriate device to school. A student owned internet capable device is now an important part of a students toolkit.

We have created an enviroment that will work with any wifi-enabled device. If you are considering purchasing a new device, it's important to keep in mind how the student is going to use the device. A laptop may be better for a senior student or a student that is interested in gaming, photography or video editing. A Chromebook maybe sufficient if they only require internet and G Suite (formerly Google Apps for Education).

Tauranga Boys' College is a G Suite School, it will work on any device with a good internet connection and its free. G Suite provides word processing, spreadsheet, presentation and email tools that can be accessed from any device, anywhere, anytime.

At no time will the following behaviours be accepted at Tauranga Boys College (or on any college services):

- Sending or displaying offensive, pornographic or anti-social material
- Using obscene or offensive language via e-mail, blog sites, forums or other electronic media
- Harassing, insulting or attacking others via any electronic means or media

Parental / Caregiver Commitment

I authorise the College to obtain further information regarding our son from his previous school(s), and to communicate it as necessary. Furthermore, information gathered by Tauranga Boys' College can be shared to any future schools, supporting agencies and organisations.

Tauranga Boys' College has advised me that the information I provide will be used for:

- Student records for the Ministry of Education and Ministry of Social Development, purposes of the Tauranga Boys' College Board of Trustees, Tauranga Boys' College Old Boys' Association, NZ Qualifications Authority (NZQA), Special Education Services (SES), statistical and/or research purposes.

I give my approval for the student enrolled to participate in off-site programmes of learning that are deemed low risk and part of the curriculum by the Principal or his Proxy.

I understand that the school will identify any foreseeable risks or hazards relating to this type of activity and implement correct management procedures to eliminate, isolate or minimise those hazards. I know that I am able to ask any questions of the school about the activity my child will be involved in, to gain a better understanding of the risks involved.

I acknowledge that at times the College may need to take rapid action for our son's welfare without recourse to us.

I acknowledge that Tauranga Boys' College is a drug free zone and that if my son is involved in a drug related incident he may be requested to provide a urine sample drug test. The test will be carried out in accordance with College procedures.

I consent to the publication of information and images featuring my son; examples of such publications include, but are not limited to newspapers, magazines, videos, electronic media, digital and online publications.

As the parent, legal guardian or caregiver of the student signing below, I grant permission for my son to access networked computer services such as the internet. I understand that some material on the internet may be objectionable, but I accept responsibility for providing guidance regarding internet use, setting and conveying standards for my son to follow when selecting, sharing or exploring information and media.

I agree to pay all fees / subject costs / levies that my son incurs while studying at Tauranga Boys' College.

Usual Place of Residence

The address given at the time of application for enrolment must be the student's usual place of residence when the school is open for instruction. The Ministry of Education has advised that parents should be warned of the possible consequences of deliberately attempting to gain unfair priority in enrolment by knowingly giving a false address or making an in zone arrangement which they intend to be only temporary, for example:

- Residing in zone on a short term basis (less than one year);
- Arranging temporary board in zone with a relative or family friend;
- Using the in zone address of a relative or friend as an "address of convenience," with no intention to live there on an ongoing basis.

If the Tauranga Boys' College Board of Trustees learns that a student is no longer living at the in zone address given at the time of application for enrolment, and has reasonable grounds to believe that a temporary in zone residence has been used for the purpose of unfairly gaining priority in enrolment at the school, then the Board will review the enrolment. Unless the parents can provide a satisfactory explanation within 10 days, the Board will annul the enrolment. This course of action is provided under Section 11(OA) of the Education Act 1989. Tauranga Boys' College may actively collect information to ensure that enrolment data provided is accurate.
