



Football

School football in New Zealand runs throughout Term 2 and Term 3 and the Tauranga Boys' College 1st X1 play in the WaiBOP Federation League 2 (<http://www.waibopfootball.co.nz>) and compete in the Super 8 and New Zealand Secondary Schools' tournaments. The WaiBOP league is a men's competition and Boys' College is the only school team in either league 1 or 2. The team's goal for this season is to gain promotion into League 1. In 2012 we were 2nd in the Super 8 tournament (losing in a penalty shootout in the final) and 8th in the NZSS Premier tournament.

The 1st X1 also plays traditional fixtures against other schools such as Auckland Grammar, St Kentigerns and Westlake Boys' High, as well as playing 5-6 qualifying matches for the NZSS tournament.

The season for the 1st X1 is often 45-50 games long. This season, the Super 8 tournament will be in Napier in July and the NZSS premier tournament will be in Taupo in September.

College has seven other senior teams that play in local under-19 leagues where our 2nd X1, 3rd X1 and top under-16 team often play against the 1st sides from local Bay of Plenty schools – such is the strength of our school's football program. Last season the 2nd X1 won the local under-19 premier league and our 3rd X1 the under-19 first division.

Junior teams (under-15) also play locally against schools and clubs. Boys' College has seven junior teams and the 'A' side won the local under-15 premier league in 2012. The school also hosts the twelve-team Hillsdene Trophy in June, which is an invitational tournament for junior players.



Both our 'A' and 'B' teams are involved and other schools come from as far away as Wellington to compete. There are also three traditional fixtures for the 'A' team against Rotorua Boys', Hamilton Boys' and St Paul's (Hamilton).
