Rowing at TBC is going from strength to strength with the team winning Gold, Silver and Bronze medals across the crews at regattas throughout the year.

Rowing at TBC is in conjunction with Tauranga Rowing Club. The first part of the season the boys predominantly row for the club in their school based crews. This includes regattas at Karapiro home of the 2010 World Championships. In Term 1 of the school year they row in the NZSS sanctioned events as well as club.

Crews train on a daily basis and travel to regattas most weekends. TBC has a 4 day rowing camp in January to hone their skills for the upcoming school based regattas.

During the off season most rowers compete in indoor rowing events. TBC Rowing has boats of all sizes for its crew. Their home base is at memorial park on the waterfront and the erg room at school.

Novices train six days a week two of those days have two sessions. U17 U18 is 13 times a week.
